

CNC OPERATOR

Overview:

Responsible for operating one or more types of computer numeric controlled production equipment. Selects appropriate settings and makes adjustments as necessary. Follows established quality and safety standards. Typically requires a high school diploma or its equivalent. Typically reports to a supervisor or manager. Typically requires 1-3 years of related experience. May be entry level if some experience in the skill Gaining or has attained full proficiency in a specific area of discipline. Works under moderate supervision

Work from drawings, patterns, templates, and specifications. Use vernier, protractor, indicator, etc. Proceed with minimum supervision and instructions.

Positions on 2nd shift hours are: 3:00-11:30pm

Positions on weekend shift hours are: sat sun 4am-4pm and Monday Tuesday or Thursday Friday 6am-3pm

Qualifications:

Education and/or Experience: High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or two to three years of related experience and / or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Physical Demands: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the necessary functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform essential functions.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand; use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls; and talk or hear. The employee frequently is required to reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to walk. The employee must regularly lift and / or move up to 25 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, and the ability to adjust focus.
